MILL HILL

Cllr Groom has installed the “traffic warning” sign using one of the posts from the signs removed last year. The dangerous tree has been felled by Eastwood Tree Services.

3 COCKED HAT (3CH)

The Working Group wish to thank Cllrs John Whitehead and Tim Passmore for funds from their Locality Budget to purchase the litter bin and signs. Cllr Soanes has the signs and bin and will be arranging a working group to install them on the 3 Cocked Hat. The bin and signs will be put on the posts removed from Broom Hill and Mill Hill last year. MSDC will empty the litter bin weekly.

As the SWT survey advised that the grass on the 3CH should be cut and raked off every 3 years, it will not need a cut until September 2024.

The Working Group wish to thank Ian Jefferies for again cutting the hedges and grass around the allotments.

NATURAL HISTORY TRAIL (NHT)
