## CPC -Suffolk County Council Thermal Imaging Camera Loan Project Update March 2023

## SUMMARY

All requests for a survey have been met and a total of 18 properties have been surveyed. Images will be sent to the people who requested a survey in the next few days.

Constraints experienced included: IT aspects of the devices; pictures could only be taken after sunset (ideally 2 hours), of dry buildings (no rain for 24 hours), low wind, temperature difference between inside and outside of at least 14 degrees; incomplete contact and property information

It is understood the Suffolk County Council Thermal Imaging Camera Loan Project will run again in autumn 2023

- Feb 22<sup>nd</sup> 2023 iOs and Android compatible cameras together with an iPad were collected from the University of Suffolk, Ipswich by Cllr Kenning
- Feb 23<sup>rd</sup> 2023 to Mar 15<sup>th</sup>
  - iPad and iOs compatible camera were used to survey 6 properties by Cllr Groom
    Android camera and personal smartphone were used to survey 12 properties by Cllr Kenning
- Mar 16<sup>th</sup> 2023 photographs from both the iPad and personal smartphone uploaded onto a personal laptop by Cllr Kenning
- Mar 17<sup>th</sup> 2023 and following days pictures batched up and emailed to property owners by Cllr Kenning
- Mar 20<sup>th</sup> 2023 iOs and Android compatible cameras together with an iPad to be returned to the University of Suffolk, Ipswich by Cllr Kenning

## Recommendation

- Participate in the re-run in the autumn
- Improve advanced publicity to increase take up in the village
- Ensure that requestors provide **all of** name, address including postcode, telephone number, email address
- Manage expectations in terms of the information that will be fed back to requestors
