Coddenham Parish Council - Coddenham Fete

After the success of last year's Fete, the intention is to hold a similar event in 2023. The proposed date is Saturday 17th June.

Rather than asking Alan West to coordinate for another year, the suggestion is that the CCRG undertake the task, with each of the CCRG's organisations picking up one (or more) area of responsibility. The Coddenham Centre will take the lead for catering and preparation of the site, including the erection of the marquees and the History Club will no doubt come up with a suitable presentation which leaves: The Shop, The Country Club, the PCC, the Day Foundation, the Gardemau Trusts and the Parish Council to support the rest.

Although absent from January's meeting I propose that the Parish Council assumes responsibility for both Stalls and Games. Clearly there are carry-overs and lessons learned from previous Fetes and Alan has agreed to provide a 'hand-over'. If Council is amenable to this proposal, I ask that one or two councillors put themselves forward to act as the 'Stalls and Games Coordinator(s)'. As I'm Chairing the CCRG until the end of May, I'll be taking the overall coordination lead, until I hand-over, so I won't have the capacity to offer myself up. Notwithstanding I'm happy to help when I can.
