Report from Broom Hill Trust Council

The bluebells this spring have been stunning and more visible in the areas cleared of bramble growth by both contractors and volunteers. However, new bramble growth is reappearing in both areas cleared by cutting and areas cleared by digging out of young growth. Hopefully, autumn volunteer work mornings will continue to keep the bramble “invasion” under control.

Following a parishioner’s comment Cllr Soanes checked the condition of the rustic style benches and noted that some repairs and maintenance are needed. It is hoped that volunteers will do the repairs and the Trust ask that Council agree an approximate budget for materials.

The Tree Survey tagged 5 trees in need of safety works within 1 year. The Trust request that the Council obtain quotes for the necessary works.
