Two PC councillors present, three other Coddenham residents and one Rectory Road Hemingstone resident.

- 1. Need for feedback from High Street residents on a possible future one way system.
- 2. Perceived need for a 40 mph on Rectory Road due its narrowness.
- 3. The group are keen to see an enforcement of the TRO (Traffic Regulation Order) for West bound vehicles over 7.5 tons.
- 4. Concern expressed about the lack of enforcement of the 20 mph speed limit.
- 5. The group welcomed the proposed improvements for the B1078/ Rectory Road junction by SCC. Next stage is to price up these works. In addition, to request the signs are double sided to warn vehicles travelling East on B 1078.
- 6. The Hemingstone resident advised that a group has been established to push for a 40mph speed limit on the B1078 through Hemingstone. The group agreed to explore if that could be a joint Hemingstone and Coddenham initiative along the B1078.
- 7. To get clarity on the 7.5 ton limit sign by the shop approach from the Bridge direction.
- 8. The group will look into establishing an off street parking solution for High Street residents.
- 9. JW and RD to draft a briefing note for HPC to keep them in the picture.
